Use of mobile phones

It has come to my attention that some parents/carers are continuing to use mobile phones around the school when dropping off and collecting children at the beginning and end of the school day. As a school, we do not allow the use of mobile phones on site. The reason for this policy is to provide and promote a safe ethos around the school for all children. For example:

- Parents/carers who are using their phones could be distracted and not aware of what their child is doing or even where they are.
- We need to ensure that there is no opportunity for people to take photographs of children around the school and use them inappropriately.

Not using a mobile phone also gives you the opportunity to talk to your child and 'catch up' at the end of a busy day.

This policy is also valid for school staff too - they are not allowed to use their phone in a public place within school during the school day (although you may see members of the Leadership Team carrying a phone for use in an emergency when on duty).

If you need to use your phone for an emergency, please inform a member of staff who will direct you to a safe place to use it and could monitor your children for you during this time.
