Safeguarding - Emergency Contacts

From time to time the school reviews its safeguarding procedures. Following a recent serious case review in another local authority, the school has reviewed some of the information we request from parents/carers. It has been highly recommended that we ensure we have up to date records of any emergency contacts that you give when your child/ren are admitted to our school. Often this information can be over 3 years old and details can change. If you are unsure as to whom the emergency contact details are for your child/ren, then please do not hesitate to contact the school office. In addition, at the next parent/carer evening on the 17th July, we will be asking you to review the key information we hold on the Data Collection sheet and adding the details of at least 3 adults to contact in the case of an emergency. Please ensure this is checked carefully, amended where necessary and handed back to the class teacher or the school office.

e-Safety - 'Snapchat app'

Last week, SnapChat, used regularly by many children and young people, launched a new feature. SnapMaps allows users to see the location of their contacts. This feature also allows others to accurately pinpoint where you are. There are three possible privacy settings:

- Ghost mode, where only you can see your position;
- My Friends mode, where any contact can see your location; and
- Select Friends mode, just those who you choose can see you.

As a parent myself, I would like to remind you that the minimum age for this app is 13 years: I would strongly recommend that if you allow your child to have the SnapChat app and SnapMaps, that you encourage them to use the 'Ghost mode'.
