Science Visits

Over the last two weeks, children in Year 5 & 6 have visited the East London Science School. The purpose of the visits was to provide science enrichment activities, taking advantage of the excellent resources available at one of our local secondary schools. The children took part in three engaging, practical activities:

- Computer Science - controlling a robot from a laptop using programming;
- Biology - testing leaves for acid content using ph testing;
- Chemistry - fire testing different materials to observe different coloured flames.

We are looking at developing an even stronger link with the East London Science School to enrich our science topics, with the aim that children become enthusiastic, knowledgeable and confident scientists.
