Attendance

Whole School Attendance Target - 96.4%

We will be working hard to achieve our yearly target. Please ensure your child attends school every day and on time.

- ✘ Children must be lined up outside their classroom door before 8:50. They will walk into class at 8:50 and be marked in late from 9:00.
- ✘ Children finish school at 15:15 and will be dismissed from their classroom door. They will be handed over to an adult that is named on the safer collection form that provides the correct password.
- ✘ If booking a dentist or GP appointment, please bring your child in so that they can be registered first. Aim to book appointments between 9:30 and 12:30, or after 13:30.
- ✘ NO term time holidays - Risk of penalty charge. Our school policy is that we do not authorise any leave during term time.

Medical

- ✘ If your child is asthmatic or has a care plan in place please ensure that their medication is in school.
- ✘ If your child requires medication to be administered during school time you **MUST** come to office to complete a care plan.
- ✘ If your child has broken or fractured bones please inform the school office before they return to school so we can arrange to complete a care plan and risk assessment.

General Reminders

- ✘ Please ensure that your child is wearing the correct uniform (including the correct footwear) every day.
- ✘ Your child should bring their reading diary to school every day. This should be signed by an adult each day and a comment made by your child.
- ✘ PE kits should remain in school for the whole half term and should not be taken home. **ALL** children **MUST** take part in PE sessions. If your child is unable to take part due to a medical reason a doctor's note must be provided.
- ✘ Your child will receive weekly homework. Please support your child to complete this each week. If you need support with your child's homework please tell an adult before the deadline. Please ensure your child's homework is presented to a high standard.
- ✘ Parents are encouraged to stay and read with their child between 8:50 and 9:00 every day.
